KCAM's Story

Rev. Vince Joy was a preacher, pilot, and visionary who clearly understood the need to communicate with people who lived in the bush areas of Alaska—some so remote that they couldn't even be reached by airplane. He saw radio as the solution to this problem.

The tower and studios were built in 1963, and by March 27, 1964, were simply awaiting final licensing from the Federal Communications Commission. At 5:36 p.m. the massive Great Alaska Earthquake hit. Civil Defense authorities requested KCAM go on the air to provide emergency communication to displaced residents of the coastal town of Valdez, which was devastated.

The strong voice of KCAM has continued to blanket the Copper River Valley with the Good News. KCAM is a vital part of the community today, providing news, music, sports and local events, and teaching programs. KCAM is the designated Emergency Broadcast System outlet in the area and stands ready to be of service during any time of need.

KCAM-FM The Light debuted in September 2011 to provide music 24/7. It is a 1,000-watt noncommercial FM licensed in Glennallen.
